### **PICTURE TOKENS, CAMERAS, AND BATTERIES**

**IFC:** When batteries are brought in by visitors, how is the determination as to what yard they go to? The cameras go through them rather quickly.

**C. O. Weller:** They are sent to the yards as needed.

**Warden:** Visitors should not have to bring in batteries, they are provided by the facility.

### **VENDING MACHINE ISSUES**

**IFC:** There have been several issues as of late with the vending machines. We request that Host Vending maintenance and clean the machines.

**C. D. Warden:** Host vending should be contacted.

**IFC:** Host vending fails to respond to emails and we would like a contact number, and for the facility to contact them regarding problems we are having with the vending machines.

### **MAILROOM/LETTERQUICK**

**IFC:** What is the status of LetterQuick?

**Warden:** Letter Quick is still a pilot program, but has been extended and it is being pushed to go statewide.

**IFC:** There have been complaints on the mail being delayed.

**Warden:** As far as I am aware the mail has been being processed per policy.

**IFC:** I sent in some Christmas cards in November and my spouse didn't receive them until the first week in January.

**Warden:** That should not be happening. We date mail when it is received at the prison.
